Part-VI.) Fire Chief's Association:

1. Submitted district's 2008-09 EMS BLS Budget to the Chief's Assn-JPA on Friday, 02/22/2008 for \$7,500.00.
2. EDC Augmentation Funds for fire districts are to be used for district's "Operations" and accountability is a **top** priority! We're one of eight EDC agencies receiving these funds, currently the actual allocation for PFD is projected to be at \$279,047.00 or approximately 30% of our total budget for fiscal years 2007/2008. A cut or loss of this funding could have grave consequences for this agency, (i.e., staffing reductions, increase response times, decrease level of service, etc).
