Part-V.) Fire Apparatus: On-going! PIO Fire's **MDT** installation for **Chief-8600** is Sept 9th; **E31's** on Sept 10th, Sept 11th for **E32's** and Sept 12th for **E38's** system from County's 07-08 Regional AFG Grant for apparatus MDT's.

Part-VI.) EMS JPA & Fire Chief's Association:

1. Approval of July 2008 JPA Bills & reviewed expenditure report thru 06/30/08, JPA's Interim Director's Report, reviewed the failure or response times for Semi-Rural areas during the month of July, met only 88.6% of calls on time, reviewed ambulance service rates, discussed Procedure-403 Revision, took action to purchase four new ambulances, took action to replace all existing gurneys with Stryker motorized gurneys and Stair Chairs.
2. August 26th letter from EDC Supervisor Rusty Dupray concerning "2008-09 Augmentation Funds" to receiving local government fire districts. They shall be frozen at the 2007-08 receiving rate. Presentation on updated EDC Design & Improvement Standards (DOT). August 27th Final draft of EDC's Rural Water Supply "Tank" Standard completed. Updated on EOC's Electronic Dispatch system, and a DGS-CMARS Survey was distributed out to all EDC fire agencies for completion.
3. Turned in **three** receipts to EDC Chief's Assn for re-imbusement for county HazMat Trailer storage containers for Decon-1, Decon-49, MCI-21, MCI-51 and MCI-85, totaling \$752.14 for PIO Fire.
