Part- II.) District Training:

There were **two** training sessions held in the **month** of **June**. **1st**, Chief's Brief, Wildland Hoselays & Pump Ops, Float-a-Pump Ops (*Hands-On) and SOG's; **2nd** Chief's Brief, EMS Safety Precautions, Wildland Fire Safety (the Ten Standard Fire Orders & Eighteen Watchout Situations), Fire Weather and SOG's.. Average attendance was eight. All shift company officers and I attended an I-110 (Wildland Fire Investigations) Course held in El Dorado Hills, Sta-86. Taught **two** HazMat FRO Classes, one @ Sta-38 and one @ Sta-51 in Garden Valley, average attendance was 18.5. Two fire personnel graduated an ICS-300 Course, and one graduated a state Driver Operator-1A Course also in June.

1. Current agency response personnel @ 19, plus one new VOL F/F trainee; plus 12-Fire Explorers/Cadets & a 20-member Grizzly Flats C.E.R.T. Team!

1. Sta-38's SCBA Cascade Air-Refill System being repaired/serviced as of this report date.
2. Precision Pump & Water Work's 3,000 gallon water re-supply project for Sta-31 (Willows) shall cost \$3,760.53. We're still awaiting some parts for the job, and it shall be completed ASAP.

Part-V.) Fire Apparatus: On-going!

1. **Sq-31** had new front ball joints and new front tires installed. **E38** had new front tires put on. **Chief-8600's** vehicle was also serviced
2. Chief-8600, E32, E38 and E238 still awaiting their final MDT programs.

1. Next County Fire Chief's Meeting & EMS-JPA Meeting to be held on Wed, July 15th @ 8: AM, County OES Room.
2. EDC OES/Fire Districts **2nd** Multi-Hazard Mitigation Plan Update Meeting was held on Thursday, June 25th. We held the 1st meeting on May 21st. This is part of the process for receiving any future declared disaster funds from the state and federal governments. It does not address day-to-day emergencies, the Plan is required to be updated every 5-years.

1. Updated personnel pay-rates with State OES, Cal-Fire and the US Forest Service for mutual-aid responses.
2. May 18th submitted the District's 2009 FEMA AFG Grant for \$35,966.06. Applied for 15 complete sets Structure Turnouts, (a "95/5%" Grant)
3. May 14th we had a successful 1st inspection with EMSA's Dr. Dave Brazzel on our District's paramedic program, the 2nd & final inspection to be held shortly. We're just now waiting for our ALS AED from the JPA.
