7.1 Chief's Report

Updates:

- 1. <u>Reserve/Volunteer program</u>: Two new reserves Tyler and Sierra started this month and are currently completing their require district orientation and training
- 2. Wildland deployment: We have had minor activity within the county but no out of county deployments
- 3. <u>Auto aid/mutual aid</u>: Working together well, I will be meeting soon with US forest service and Cal Fire and our County Emergency services providers and neighbors
- 4. Annexation: None to report
- 5. Crews: Vacation season for several of our staff, we seem to have everything covered, nothing further to report
- **6.** Administration: Joy has been working franticly catching up on office items, and updating me on district responsibility's. We have made our way to the county offices and she will be letting me fly on my own soon.
- 7. <u>EMS Program:</u> I have been approached by several community members asking questions regarding an EMS program. I have met with the county EMS director and the doctor. We will be scheduling meetings in the future.
- 8. <u>Training programs</u>: We are currently reevaluating the districts training and programs, I will have more to report in August.
- 9. Station 38 (Main)
- 10. Station 37 (OMO Ranch): School is still utilizing facility for storage, water supply functioning
- 11. Station 35 (Grizzly): We have one engine at this station, man door was fixed but the main OH door is OOS (can open from inside manually)
- 12. Station 34 (Mt. Aukum) PVFA still utilizing for storage
- 13. <u>Station 32 (Sandridge)</u> We have our water-tender at this station along with PVFA Historic Engine, man door is OOS
- 14. <u>Station 31 (Willow)</u> We have one patrol (Rescue/Brush unit) at this station with command rig after 5PM. HVAC/AC unit OOS. Back porch repaired, OH door is now functioning properly and we purchased a 3 in 1 printer replacing the non-functioning printer.

15. Facilities:

- St. 31: Kitchen sink is leaking, garbage disposal frozen not working, woodpecker damage to exterior of building (will be working with PVFA on future repair) tow damaged windows need replacing in future. AC unit will be worked on this week
- St. 32 Man door is damaged beyond repair, will need to be replaced soon
- St. 35 OH door will be worked on this week, we will need to replace open ceiling that was damaged during installation of OH door and door expansion
- St. 38 We will be conducting a safety walk through in August with the Captains and crews
- Administration Again we will be conducting a safety walk through in August with staff
- 16. <u>Staffing Information</u>: St. 38 minimum of two career with a maximum of 4 (two reserve during peak fire season, St. 31 one career after 5pm, administration office Tue-Thu 0900-1PM, duty chief staffing during day M-F.

- 18. Water supply: A few applications have been reviewed for personal residential water supply
